H4Y & Crossnore partner to bring a new foster parenting model to WNC

Homes for Youth is partnering with Crossnore to implement a new program in North Carolina called professional foster parenting. Professional foster parenting consists of having paid staff who are a foster parent couple, at least one of whom does not work outside the home, to provide services for youth in the foster care system. Having paid professionals in the home means trained staff who have the tools and experience to provide a therapeutic environment for kids most in need. Homes for Youth will provide the homes and Crossnore will supervise the foster parents and provide therapeutic services to the youth in the home. We're excited to partner with Crossnore on the pilot program in North Carolina.
